## Here are things we can do for the people we have named:

- C. I will serve them in a meaningful way 2 times in the next month.
- D. I will give them gospel-centered literature (book, app, podcast, etc.) and follow-up about it.
- E. I will personally share Jesus with them and pray with them 1 time in the next month.
